We expect all those carrying out research at Colchester County High School for Girls to conform to the BERA ethical guidelines for educational research ([www.bera.ac.uk](http://www.bera.ac.uk))

All researchers will be offered appropriate support from the school. This could take the form of:

- Inset/CPD time to undertake research and present findings
- Research mentors
- Guidance and support from external networks (e.g. CamSTAR)
